The girls should be so proud of themselves, they represented Midhurst perfectly; showing brilliant sportsmanship and kindness to all. Well done!


PINE CLASS CHROMATOGRAPHY





Congratulations to Pine Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 266 points. Well done Pine Class!




Wey House have taken the lead this week with 1592 points so far this term. Arun House are only 1pt. behind them on 1591.
