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Happy Friday Everyone.

Did you know that every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 is entitled to a Universal Free School Meal? All you need to do is order it online using your ParentPay app.

More importantly as well as Universal Free School meals your child may be entitled to Free School Meals. Free School Meals is something completely different to Universal Free School Meals as eligibility also comes with a Pupil Premium Grant, currently £1480. This grant can be used to support your child's education such as funding wrap around care, supporting your child on school trips and residentials and much more. We do find that parents who are eligible are put off applying for Free School Meals until the end of Year 2 as they feel that their child is already receiving a universal free school meal. I would urge all parents to check their eligibility from the list below and use the link to apply if appropriate by using the link.

Free school meals in all West Sussex maintained and free schools and academies are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

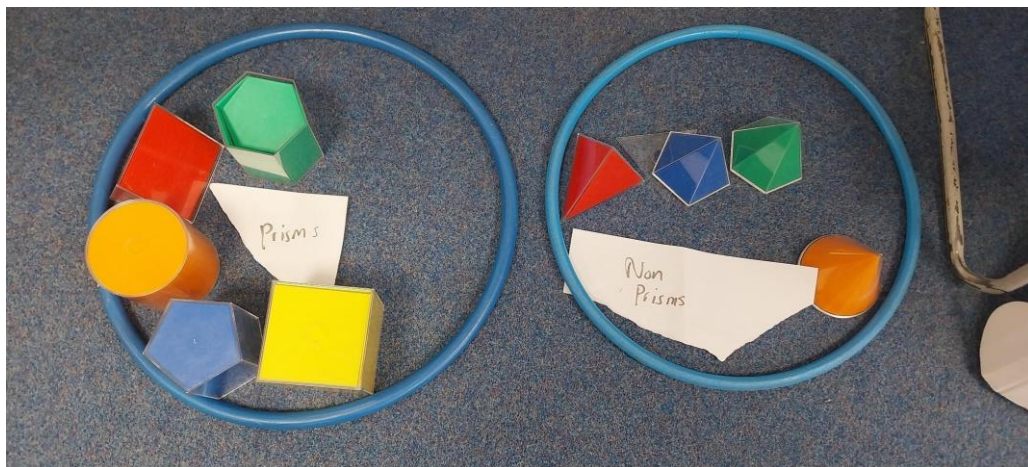

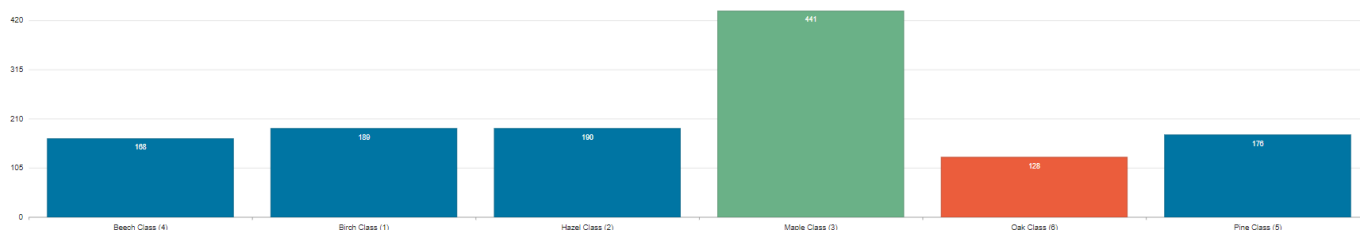

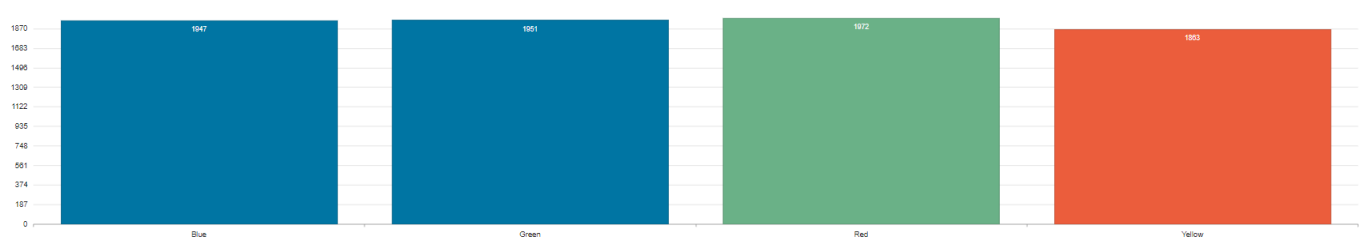

Congratulations to Maple Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 441 points. Well done Maple Class!

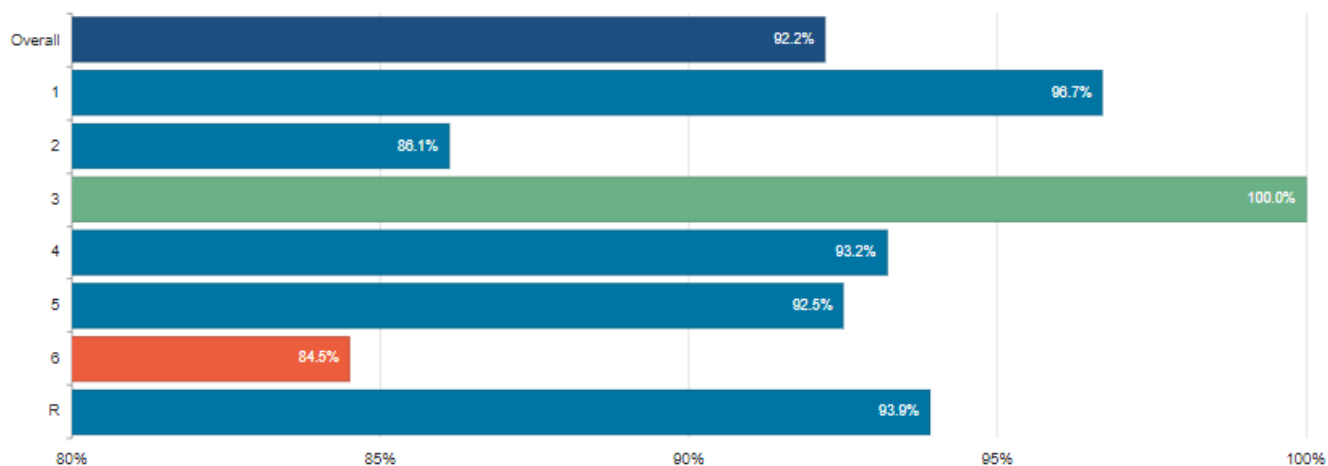


Arun House have retaken the lead this week with 1972 points so far this term.



## WEEKLY ATTENDANCE

This week's overall attendance is 92.2%. This is 2.8% lower than our statutory target of 95% and is the lowest attendance data since the start of the year. Looking at the data from this week the low attendance figures can be explained by the number of children taken out of school for unauthorised holidays. At Midhurst Primary School, we believe that regular attendance throughout the year is essential to every child's success and fulfilment. Our current target for attendance is 95% so this allows only 9 days per year for sickness. I think it prudent to advise that new statutory guidance on attendance in schools comes into force in September. The new guidance makes it clear the role schools have in issuing Fixed Penalty Notices in relation to pupil absence.
