

Frances & Charlie added, "I recommend any of the grown-ups from our school go to Champs Hill on one of their charity open days!"


Lacey said, "I found all the paintings inspiring!"

Finally, Darcy added, "It is such a lovely place, so peaceful and beautiful and calm."




BEHAVIOUR POINTS

Congratulations to Pine Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 267 points. Well done Pine Class!




Rother House have retaken the lead this week with 2191 points so far this term.
