Happy Friday Everyone.

So, at last the time we have all been waiting for has arrived! Sun and warm weather! I do not want to jinx the prospect of sun but with the recent, and hopefully ongoing, sunny weather, we would like to remind you that staff are unable to apply sun cream to children and therefore ask you to ensure that you apply sunscreen (SPF 20 or above) before they come into school in the morning. Parents may still send in their own sun cream for their child to re-apply themselves and this should be clearly labelled with their name and handed to their teacher. We would encourage our children to wear sun hats on sunny days, as this can also protect them from the sun's rays when they are playing or working outside. In Acorns (Reception), much of our time is spent in the outdoors so this is really important protection.

As well as the sunny weather, we begin to near the end of the academic year and with that comes the inevitable end of year celebrations. On Monday of next week our Year 6s travel to Chichester Cathedral for their Leavers Service. After the service we will eat our lunches together in the Bishops Palace Gardens – so Year 6 parents please send your child to school with a packed lunch. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ABOUT FIXED PENALTY NOTICES

A letter from West Sussex County Council will be sent to you all today via the children. As you may be aware, the Government has introduced a new national framework for Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs), announced in February 2024, as part of the working together to improve school attendance statutory guidance for schools and local authorities. I would ask that you read the letter very carefully particularly if you have or are about to ask for leave of absence for your child. The letter clearly states the new framework which comes into force from 19th August 2024. In short, the new national framework clearly expects the issue of fixed penalty notices to parents.


FOREST SCHOOLS

The School Choir took part in the West Sussex Music Big Sing event on Tuesday! Here they are rocking the crowds with Somewhere Only We Know by Keane!


MRC SPORTS DAY

Pine Class had a great day at MRC yesterday. A special mention to Oscar C, who set a new record for vortex throw. An incredible 36m!




BEHAVIOUR POINTS

Congratulations to Birch Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 250 points. Well done Birch Class!




Rother House remain in lead this week with 2528 points so far this term.
