For this reason, please do not park in Ashfield Road on these days, and if you must do so for a short time, do not park over gulleys or it will not be possible to carry out this long-awaited work.





Congratulations to Beech Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 252 points. Well done Beech Class!




Congratulations to Rother House who are currently in the lead with 3373 pts.





West Sussex County Council is prioritising public realm improvements to Chichester city centre. The existing public realm within the pedestrianised zones of East and North Streets is deteriorating and the current surface has reached the end of its useful life. The Council want to hear your views on proposed improvements to North and East Street in the Chichester city centre.

Until **29 November 2024**, you have a chance to submit your views on the concept designs and influence the future of Chichester city centre. We invite the public to look through the information <u>on our webpage</u> and complete the **survey at the bottom of the page**.

Another way to be part of this engagement is to attend one of our sessions or meet the team at the following events:

- 13 and 27 November, 10:00 16:00 outside the Chichester City Council offices on North Street
- 15 November at our market stall in Chichester Farmers Market
