listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.'


#### **BIRCH CLASS AND THE WATER CYCLE**





Congratulations to Beech Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 194 points. Well done Beech Class




Rother House remain in the lead this week with 6583 points so far this year.


