#### **EXCITING YEAR \$ TRIP TO BUTSER ANCIENT FARM**

On Monday, Year 4 had an amazing trip to Butser Ancient Farm, where they stepped back in time to experience life in the past! The day was filled with hands-on activities that brought history to life.

The children explored real-life reconstructions of Anglo-Saxon and Viking houses, seeing how people lived over a thousand years ago. Inside the smoky, thatched-roof homes, they imagined what it would have been like to cook, sleep, and work in those times.

One of the highlights of the day was taking part in an archaeological dig. The children became miniarchaeologists, carefully uncovering hidden treasures and learning how experts discover the past through artifacts buried in the ground.





Congratulations to Birch Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 379 points. Well done Birch Class




Rother House remain in the lead this week with 7702 points so far this year.
